Camp Kerala is a haven for those who love the Festival but who also appreciate luxury and chic sophistication.

Camp Kerala @ Glastonbury is owned and run by Jennifer Lederman. She and her team will again be inviting guests to join her and to stay in one of her 80 shikar tents for Glastonbury 2011. Camp Kerala is located on private land offering spectacular views over the entire festival site. It is a three minute walk to Gate C of the festival but there are Camp Kerala vehicles on hand throughout the day and most of the night (!) to ferry guests to and from the Interstage area. There also golf buggies available to ferry guests back from Gate C

Each shikar tent sleeps two people. The cost includes: Two Interstage Area Festival Tickets (which give additional access to the Interstage Area where the Camp Kerala Winnebago will be parked), all food for the festival period, use of the renowned Camp Kerala facilities, including access to the Kerala Spa, Camp Kerala's concierge service and the gorgeous Camp Kerala Logistics team .

Guests will stay in one of Camp Kerala's romantic, sumptuous shikar tents. The tents are designed and manufactured by the Maharaja of Jodhpur. They are furnished with Rajasthaní furniture and can be made up with a king sized bed or two single beds. The sheets are Egyptian cotton, the duvets are Hungarian duck down and the mattresses are the world's most comfortable (in our view!) and come from Italy. There are sheepskin rugs on the floors and an endless supply of linen.

The efficient, professional and friendly Camp Kerala team will be on hand at all times to ensure

the ultimate in service. The Camp Kerala loos and showers have been described as the “most immaculate ever seen”. There are banks of showers and loos available with easy access to all the tents.

A great new addition this year is the Kerala Spa, where our therapists will be available to offer holistic massages, festival hairdos, make-up sessions and all types of beauty therapies.

The most delicious food will be served. Brunch will be from 8:30 am - 12pm, All Day menu and Daily Special menu from 1pm - 1am. All produce locally sourced where possible.

The views from the famous Camp Kerala site are unsurpassable. Guests from previous years have been totally taken aback by the awesome beauty of the location. It has been said that it has to be seen to be believed. Guests are welcome to bring their guests back to enjoy the extraordinarily exciting atmosphere of the Chill Out Area. David Rivet, from the Blizzard Hotel in Val D'Isere, will be on hand to mix guests an array of his world renowned cocktails.

At the Camp Kerala Interstage Winnebago the Camp Kerala staff will be ready to offer guests a wonderful place to sit and soak in the Interstage atmosphere. The all important Camp Kerala loos will be there!

The Camp Kerala Logistics team will ensure that guests will have to do the minimal amount of walking

On arrival guests will be met at a pre arranged point by the Camp Kerala logistics team and brought on site avoiding any traffic jams. Those arriving by helicopter will be met at a helipad and again brought on site by the Camp Kerala team.



Camp Kerala @ Glastonbury 2011



The dates for the Glastonbury Festival 2011 are Friday 24th, Saturday 25th and Sunday 26th of June. Guests of Camp Kerala can arrive anytime after mid day on Thursday 23rd and are welcome to stay until midday on Monday 27th.

This year we are offering two tiers of charges. For those guests wishing to arrive on Thursday the cost will be £8,000 plus vat. And for guests who would like to join us on Friday the cost will be £7,500 (plus vat)
The cost, which ever rate is required, will include:

1. Luxury accommodation, for two, in one of Camp Kerala's Shikar tents for the Glastonbury Festival Period 2011, including the Camp Kerala Team on hand to provide the ultimate in service.
2. Two Interstage Area Festival Tickets which give access to the Interstage area between The Pyramid and the Other Stage.
3. Exclusive access to the Camp Kerala Interstage Winnebago.
4. All food provided 17hrs a day. Brunch will be served from 8:30 am - 12pm, all day menu and daily special menu from 1pm - 1am.
5. Access to the Camp Kerala Chill Out Area, dining tents and all other Camp Kerala facilities.
6. Access to Camp Kerala massage therapists and hairdressers in the Kerala Spa.
7. Access to the Camp Kerala Logistics Team on hand on arrival and departure of guests.
8. Regular shuttles to and from the Camp Kerala site to the Interstage area from 11am – 2am.
9. Secure Parking on Camp Kerala site and security on site 24hrs a day.
10. Access to the Camp Kerala Concierge Team.

In addition Camp Kerala is offering a small number of tents with plumbed in ensuite loos at an additional cost of £750 +vat per tent.

Divan beds can be included in the tents at an additional cost of £300 (+vat)
